



In the parking lot, Mom tells me to watch for moving cars. I keep a safe distance so drivers can see me.




I see so many car seats in the store.
"Mom! I want that one," I say.




I sit in my favorite car seat, but Mom says it's too big. "Maybe next year after you grow some more."




Mom picks out a car seat and I sit in it.
It's the perfect size for me!




Now that I have a brand new car seat,

I have to be quiet on the way so I don't distract Mom. I see all the traffic signs she taught me about.



**Car Seat Requirements
and Statistics**

TYPE	AGE	WEIGHT	HEIGHT
REAR FACING (non convertible)	 Birth - 3 Years	 20-35 LB MAX	Check Manufacturer Requirements
FORWARD FACING	 1 Year + 	MIN  20 LB	Check Manufacturer Requirements
BOOSTER SEAT (high/no back)	 4 - 8  Years	 100 LB MAX	4' 9" MAX





For children 4-7 years, booster seats reduce risk of injury by 59% versus seat belts alone

Child safety seats reduce the risk of death in passenger vehicles by 71% for infants and by 54% for toddlers ages 1-4.

COMMON CHILD SAFETY SEAT INSTALLATION MISTAKES

1. Not using the correct safety seat for a child's size and age
2. Not placing the child safety seat in the correct direction
3. Incorrect installation of the child safety seat in relation to the vehicle's airbags
4. Incorrect installation and tightness of the child safety seat to the vehicle seat
5. Not securing or tightening the safety seat's harness and crotch straps
6. Improper use of the locking clips for certain vehicle's safety belts
